



TSR Comprehensive

The following is a summary of the materials, equipment, and professional development opportunities provided to TSR Comprehensive participants.

PARTICIPATING PROGRAMS AND SCHOOL LEADERS RECEIVE:

- **Administrator professional development course** as well as **Administrator-Classroom Observation Tool (A-COT)**, which provides school leaders with a learning experience that supports them in evaluating instructional quality and setting goals for improvement. Tools provided with the course allow school administrators to track growth in instructional quality and graph the performance of teachers on their campus;
- **Substitute teacher reimbursement** for year 1 Head Start and child care target teachers participating in the required CIRCLE (2 days) and Progress Monitoring (1 day) trainings;
- **Reports** on teacher change and child progress throughout the year;
- **Tools to support family engagement**, including family friendly CIRCLE Progress Monitoring Reports and online educational resources for enrolled families;
- **Training opportunities for Infant and Toddler Teachers and Directors** linked to the Infant and Toddler to Three Year Old Early Learning Guidelines;
- **Enhanced provider reimbursement rates by Texas Workforce Commission**, at least 5% greater than the standard published rate, for preschool children (check with check with TWC local board postings).

PARTICIPATING CLASSROOMS RECEIVE:

- The **CIRCLE Progress Monitoring System**, a child progress monitoring tool that is used to assess children three times during the year;
- A **School Readiness Kit**, which contains a variety of books and materials used to support and enhance classroom instruction, for each new participating Head Start and childcare classroom, if needed;
- A choice of an **Approved Primary Curriculum**, if needed, which includes high-quality and developmentally appropriate instructional materials with activities and guides will be provided for new participating Head Start and childcare classrooms that do not have an approved curriculum;
- A **Classroom Start-Up Kit**, which contains materials for effectively organizing and managing the preschool classroom, for each new participating Head Start and childcare classroom, if needed;
- The **Developing Talkers** or **Hablemos Juntos Kit**, a supplemental language and literacy curriculum, for classrooms provided in parts during all three years of lead teacher participation in the project.

PARTICIPATING TEACHERS RECEIVE:

- **CIRCLE Preschool Foundations Training** for year 1 teachers. This is a hands-on research-based workshop that provides Pre-kindergarten teachers with an overview of literacy, language, math and best practices for the early childhood classroom;
- **CIRCLE Activity Collection**, which includes a variety of engaging and effective educational activities that can be easily implemented in the classroom;
- Training to implement child progress monitoring tools;
- **eCIRCLE Professional Development coursework** designed to build content knowledge and specific skills across numerous areas of early childhood education. Teachers have access to approximately 100 hours of course content that is aligned with selected CDA requirements. Teachers attend facilitated sessions of this course material;
- **Ongoing Coaching** (face-to-face or remote services varies by location, funding, and need) will be provided to all participating teachers from Head Start and childcare programs. Coaches support implementation of course objectives and help teachers learn to integrate child progress monitoring data with instruction;
- **Equipment**, such as video cameras and portable computers, to support project implementation, as needed;
- **Incentive Pay up to \$1000**, upon successful completion of project requirements, at the end of the school year.
